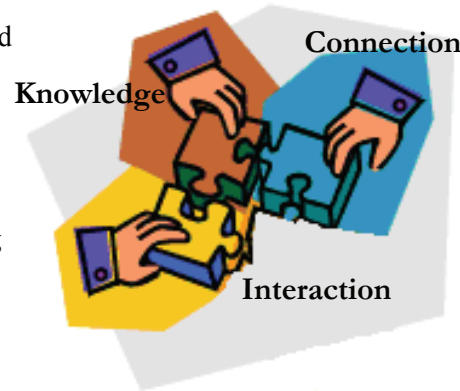
Perspectives: A Look at Alzheimer's disease

This 8-hour workshop is designed to help participants understand the complexities of dementia and Alzheimer's disease from different perspectives. Staff are called upon in their role to work with many different individuals, each coming from a different perspective. This workshop is designed to help bring those perspectives together so that the resident / client with Alzheimer's disease is treated with respect and dignity, ensuring their needs are met. Perspectives presented will include the family member, resident, spiritual, recreational therapist, social worker, nurse, psychologist, and conclude with the research perspective.



Course Objectives

At the completion of the 8-hour course, participants will be able to:

- Identify components and understand the difference between an activity and a therapy and their impact on the environment
- Understand the impact Alzheimer's disease has on the families and be able to list strategies for working more closely together
- Understand, from a resident's perspective, what it is like to live with Alzheimer's disease and apply what is shared back in the facility with staff
- Recognize the four Stages of Assistance in care giving and be able to identify at least two useful techniques for providing personal care
- Identify two positive action steps that can be taken to alleviate caregiver burnout and understand the negative consequences resulting from unaddressed burden/stress
- List at least three possible triggers that may lead to behavioral outbursts and be able to identify at least three approaches to de-escalating challenging behaviors
- Identify multiple health factors that may increase the risk for developing cognitive decline or dementia due to Alzheimer's disease
- Identify at least one of the three criteria for defining preclinical Alzheimer's disease and at least 3 biomarkers found in the model of preclinical stages
